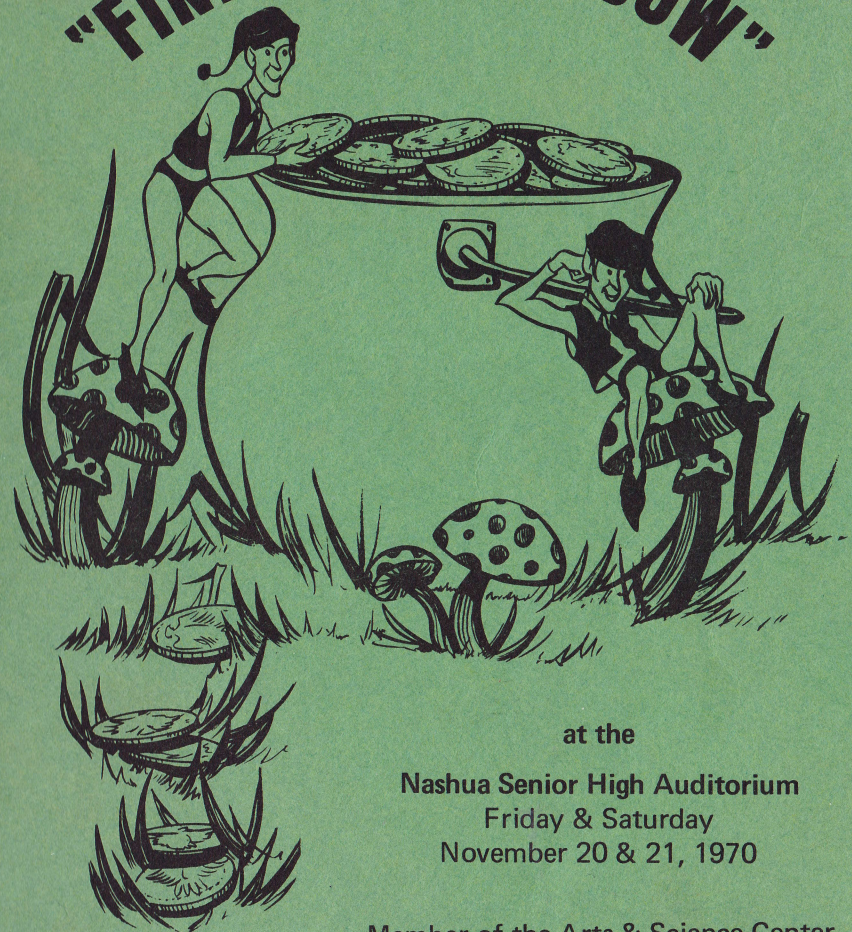

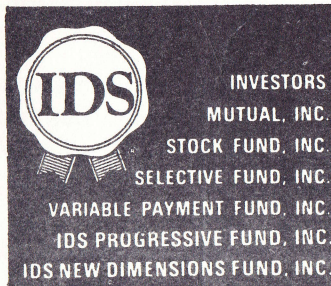

IN THE SPOTLIGHT

He has previously appeared with the Actorsingers in their productions of "Bohemian Girl", "Naughty Marietta", "HMS Pinafore" and "Student Prince". We are sure you will enjoy his delightful interpretation of "Og" in tonight's show.

GRACE BOLEN — For Actorsinger productions Grace has directed the "Student Prince" and appeared as "Mrs. Harcourt" in "Anything Goes". She has also directed and performed with the Nashua Theatre Guild and the Bedford and Newton Players. Grace is associated with the Boston College Dramatics Society and Boston College Summer Theatre, New England Chapter.

LORRAINE COLLINS — Has supported the chorus in many shows with her beautiful voice. She has also had the lead in "Iolanthe" and "Trial by Jury". Lorraine is a member of the "Choraliers" and the Episcopal Church Choir. She has also worked on props and concessions for the Junior Actorsingers Shows.

She has danced in many shows including: "Carousel", "Paint Your Wagon", "Dangerous World", "Lord Jim", "Water Study", "Brigadoon", "Kiss Me Kate", "King & I" and many more. She has performed and taught in New York and Massachusetts as well. We welcome this lovely and talented performer to our group tonight as both our choreographer and our "Susan".

AL MILLER — Actorsingers first saw Al as 'Stewpot' in "South Pacific". With the Eastern Guild he was 'Ensign Pulver' in "Mr. Roberts". He has sung in the choruses of "Annie Get Your Gun", "Desert Song" and "South Pacific". In "Guys and Dolls" he played 'Benny Southstreet' and 'Jeb' in "Showboat". Al will perhaps best be remembered by Actorsinger audiences as 'Moonface Martin' in "Anything Goes". Since then he appeared in "Ankles Away" and as 'Ito' in the Actorsingers most recent production "Mame".

JO MILLETT — A well known Nashua area organist and music teacher. Jo has been accompanist for Actorsingers for many years. THE ACTORSINGERS

The present organization of Actorsingers made its debut as a performing group in January 1955, when the members presented "Bohemian Girl". Since that time they have performed on an average of twice a year, demonstrating their versatility by running the scale from Gilbert & Sullivan to nostalgic Victor Herbert and Strauss shows, from modern Menotti works to Besoyan. In response to popular request, they have gone on to "big time" musicals with successful presentations of "Brigadoon", "Kiss Me Kate", "South Pacific", "Annie Get Your Gun", "Desert Song", "Showboat", "Anything Goes", "Student Prince" and last spring's production of "Mame" which was accorded another standing ovation.

Since 1955, the Actorsingers have offered to the citizens of Nashua and surrounding communities good entertainment of a musical-dramatic nature. Its ever-swelling membership has an opportunity to express and develop individual talents in stage performance, costume designing and construction, choreography, make-up and many technical skills so vital to a show's success.

The name "Actorsingers" was adopted as most descriptive of the double challenge of bringing to Nashua, productions requiring good musicianship and acting.

The group is a non-profit, non-denominational organization incorporated in June 1961, and is governed by a set of by-laws and its Executive Board which meets once a month. There are no dues for membership.

The Junior Actorsingers, an off-spring of the parent group, is made up of children of the Actorsingers and patrons. These youngsters, ranging in age from 8 to 12, perform in an operetta in the spring of each year.
