But in the responsible hands of the production coordinators lies the monumental task of organizing every committee and seeing every duty is fulfilled and on schedule. It is Linda and Betty who have been our "problem solvers" and "trouble shooters."

Betty Badeau has been an Actorsinger for almost 25 years and did make-up and hair for the first "Kiss Me Kate" (1965). She is "one of those members" who is always there when you need her and gets the job done. She is responsible month after month for the printing of the newsletter "Footlights." Betty could surely be called one of the "first ladies" of the Actorsingers.

Linda Saren is a new member of the Board of Directors and is new at the Production Coordinator's job. But her years of theatre background assisted her tremendously in undertaking the Production Coordinator's role. Linda, a court reporter for ten years, has written, produced and directed her own shows. She was the recipient of a drama scholarship to Catholic University and she has appeared in "Born Yesterday" as Billy Dawn and "Trojan Women" as Helen of Troy.

Sally was recently seen portraying the faded movie queen in Charles Wilbert's "The Other End of An Ice Cream Cone" at the Palace Theatre in Manchester and, coincidentally; is another member of the cast of "Kiss Me Kate" who is a former Miss New Hampshire.

Other credits include "Seagull," "Three Sisters," "The Appletree," "Camelot," "Bus Stop," "Godspell," and the leading role in "Cabaret."







#### **Music Director**

Steve Norris, the music director at Nashua High School, has done eight other shows for the Actorsingers. He was our music director for the first "Kiss Me Kate" (1965), which coincidentally, was also his first show with the Actorsingers. We are proud to say Steve tells us that because he remembers it as such a pleasant experience for him, he was eager to work with the Actorsingers again on the revival of this Cole Porter favorite. And, indeed, this dedicated and witty music director would be a welcome addition to any theatre organization.

One of Steve's greatest achievements is that under his direction, Nashua High is known as having one of the best bands in the country, and as a result, the band won the Cherry Blossom Festival in Washington, D.C. in 1975.

Since so much of the musical score and dance numbers in "Kiss Me Kate" are dependent on an exceptionally talented pianist, the Actorsingers are fortunate to have Jo Millett as accompanist. #### Bill Calhoun (Lucentio)




