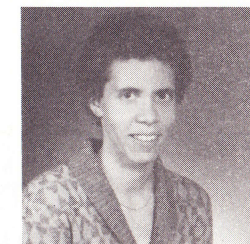
Ron Simonian CHOREOGRAPHER

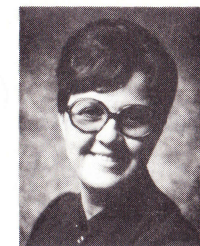

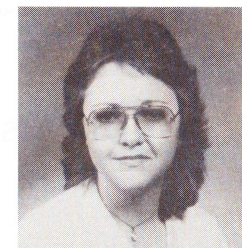
Elaine Duhamel . . PRODUCTION MANAGER

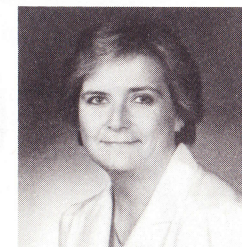
Kathy Raby CAST COORDINATOR

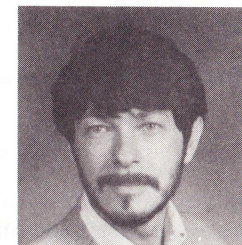
Kathy Vallier STAGE MANAGER

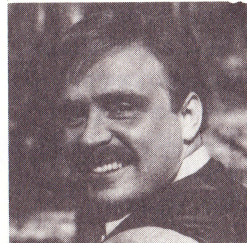
Sylvia Silvio Greenberg FANNY BRICE

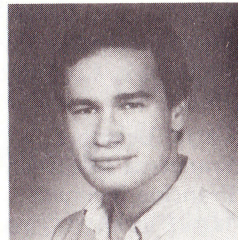
Gene Bombara NICK ARNSTEIN

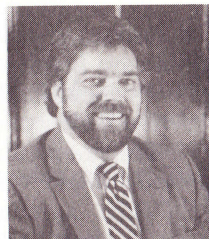
David Olmstead EDDY RYAN
