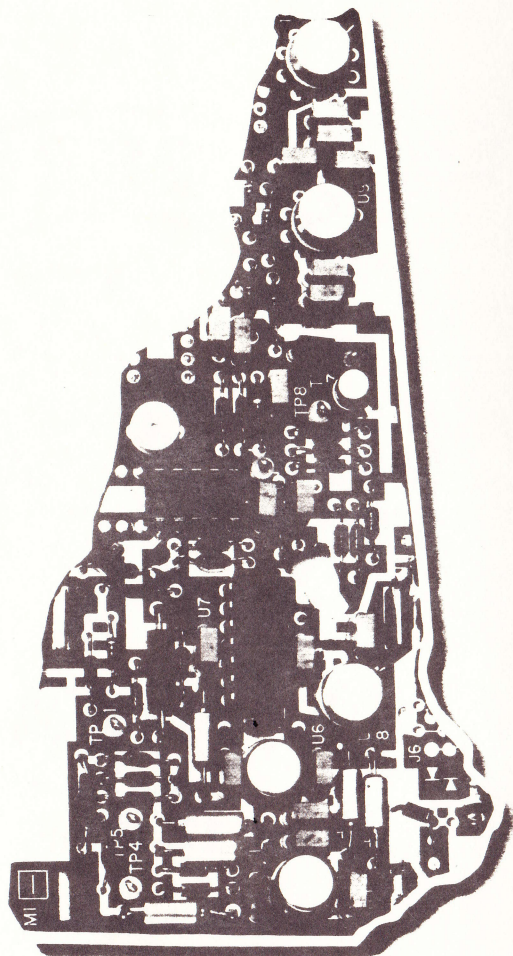

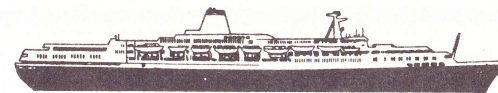

Dramatics Director.....Mark C. Hand
We welcome Mark on his first directorial excursion with the Actorsingers. You may however, remember him as Roger, the mooning champ of Rydell High in our spring production of GREASE. His experience ranges from co-directing LIL ABNER and GUYS AND DOLLS for Nashua High School to choreographing WEST SIDE STORY and THE MUSIC MAN for the Actorsingers in the past two years. Mark is more than actively involved with the Actorsingers currently serving as a member of the Board of Directors and co-editor of our newsletter.

Music DirectorSteve Norris
In November of 1987, Steve was the music director for the Actorsingers production of THE MUSIC MAN. He has done quite a number of shows for us over the years including GUYS AND DOLLS, SOUTH PACIFIC, FIDDLER, HELLO, DOLLY, OLIVER!, SHOW BOAT, and KISS ME KATE. Steve is the director of Nashua High School's Chorus and Chamber Choir, and is former director of Nashua High's award winning marching band. This year's chamber singers were awarded first place in a national competition in Washington, D.C.

Choreographer.....Pat Ross
Our last show, GREASE, was choreographed by Pat. She was already familiar with ANYTHING GOES when she began working on this production. Pat has both had the role of Bonnie and previously choreographed the show. She has danced professionally with the Pittsburgh Ballet co. and the Pittsburgh Light Opera Co. In Nashville, she was a featured dancer in HAIR. Pat has choreographed for numerous actors and dancers including well-known child stars in ANNIE. "You're the top".



Stage Manager.....Don Jeffrey
Don has been very actively involved with the Actorsingers for a number of years. His first show with us was ONCE UPON A MATTRESS in the spring of 1982. The former Penny Award winner was also the stage manager for GUYS AND DOLLS, and OLIVER! He was the lighting designer for our 1989 spring production of GREASE, and when he's not busy chairing one of these committees he's always helping out backstage. His wife Lori has also been in many of our shows and we hope their 2 daughters Kimberly and Joline are future Actorsingers.

Set DesignKathy Lovering
Kathy and her husband, Bob, have a 1 1/2 year old daughter Emily and expect their second child at any moment. Kathy has been on stage for many shows and has contributed in some major capacity to each show since 1977. GREASE, PETER PAN, THE MUSIC MAN, THE WIZ, and HELLO DOLLY were designed and stage managed by her. Several shows have been written and directed by Kathy for First Church, U.C.C.

Lighting DesignDavid Kasok
Dave worked on lighting and design for Actorsingers shows, GREASE, THE HOBBIT, and THE VELVETEEN RABBIT. He last performed with us in THE MUSIC MAN and MACK AND MABEL. For the 1986-87 Nashua High School Communicate Show David used his talents as a director. He is the General Manager of Freddie's Transmission in Hudson. 5'9", handsome...

Production Coordinator....Valerie Levesque
Val has two sons who are members of the Jr. Actorsingers and for the past three years she has most often offered to help wherever needed. During ANYTHING GOES, she has been working with the adults for the first time. Val also puts much effort into her job as the transportation coordinator of the Elderly and Handicapped Bus Service of Nashua. We have found her to be a most valuable asset.

Costume Design/Asst. Prod. Coordinator.....Shirley Coutu
Shirley has designed for several shows including her two favorites, THE WIZ, and GREASE. She has held many positions on committees, is on our Board of Directors, and has headed our audition boards. Shirley and her husband, Moe (playing Billy in this production) have 3 sons and own *Act I Video* in Dracut. Actorsingers has announced her as the winner of this year's Penny Award.

Assistant Stage Manager.....Jack Spitale
Jack resides in Peperell MA. This is his first show with us. He is also a member of the Groton Theatre where this year he produced CABARET and was stage manager of THE FOREIGNER. Jack has also been involved in plays for North Middlesex Players and Indian Hill Arts. In his "spare" time, he is a freshman at Mount Wachuset Community College, is an EMT and works for Nashoba Cable Television.

Assistant Choreographer.Leslie Glow Jarvis
Leslie hails from Massachusetts. She has appeared in DAMN YANKEES, KISS ME KATE, CABARET, and for us, WEST SIDE STORY, and MACK AND MABEL. For over 3 years, Leslie has taught aerobica at Harte-Hanks Technologies and also has taught for the Physical Education Department at UNH. A devote of tap and a former student of Gay Nardone, Leslie presently studies with Cathy Bernard at The Dancing Corner.

Moe has twice directed shows for the Actorsingers; our productions of THE WIZ and, most recently,PETER PAN. You will undoubtedly remember one of his best roles for us as Fagin in OLIVER! Moe is a former president of our organization. For ten years he has also been a hockey coach. "If it isn't fun, don't do it."

MOONFACE.....ED WALL
Welcome home, Ed! In 1984, Ed received the Best Actor Award from N.H.C.T.A. here in New Hampshire. While living in Florida, he was nominated in the Tampa Bay area for Best Supporting Actor in a Musical for 1988-1989. Ed's been in many, many of our shows and last played Vandergelder in HELLO, DOLLY. At the movies, he can be seen in *Coupe de Ville*, soon to be released. Ed and Mary are happy to return to Nashua.


BONNIE.....DONNA O'BRYANT
