



Director's Note

"The Warner Brothers are making a whole talking picture with this gadget. The Jazz Singer. They'll lose their shirts!" That's what the character, R.F. Simpson said about a machine that could make talking movies.

It's hard to believe that ninety years ago, talking movies were something folks just couldn't fathom. And look at us now! In less than a century, we not only have talking movies, we have cell phones that can play movies, take pictures, and tell us how to reach a destination. We don't have to call folks on the phone or write letters— we text them or send them an e-mail. And we don't have to crack open a volume of Funk and Wagnalls to do a history paper for school—we simply look it up on line or on our cell phone!

My mother was born the year after "Singin' in the Rain" takes place. Before she passed, we used to visit her in the nursing home, and my daughter would skype with my brother in Florida. Mom could not understand why Michael was on a TV and was talking to her! Or we'd try to call another relative on a cell phone, but mom would stare blankly at the device. Then it dawned on me....this gadget didn't look at all like the phones she was used to... It's just mind-boggling to think how far we've advanced. It's as if we're living in the world of the Jetsons!

It has been a great deal of fun to step back in time to prepare for this show. It took a good amount of research to make the costumes, properties, and hairstyles look authentic to the period. Luckily, we have people in our company who strive to make things look just right. And we have the talent of Judy Hayward who brings this beautiful score to life and Lara Hyde who captured the dances of that era in her choreography. Then we add our extremely talented cast to the mix. We started this adventure a little over two months ago with just a script – and look how far we've come!

So come on back to 1927 with us. There wasn't a war, there wasn't a depression yet...and we were all unplugged! I hope you enjoy our show...thank you so much for joining us!
