Director's Note

Reefer Madness is a show that seems like a period piece that is completely unrelatable, but as I look at this piece and look at the news now, I can't help but see the similarities. We live in a day and age where information travels so quickly and yet it is not always used for good. This show is based on the public service announcement by the same title. A time right before World War Two when propaganda ran rampant and fact checking was not as easy to do as it is now. Now, though with technology in the palm of our hands we are facing the same problem, just going by a different name. We are facing Fake News.

Reefer Madness was Fake News before anyone knew what that term was. It was a scare tactic used to make Marijuana seem extremely dangerous. The worst part about this video is that it worked and some of the arguments that were used against Marijuana then in that PSA are still used today. What this musical does is not only shine a light on how outrageous the claims against the drug are, but it also shines a light on the willingness people back then had to believe it.

It seems comical that anyone would take this seriously but I think of fake stories that come out now. Celebrities dying, conspiracies, or even accusations that turn into news regardless of if they are true or not. Yes, a lot has changed but not enough. This musical shows us this, and I hope that all watching this will reflect on how fast they are to believe something they read or hear without thinking about it, as well as the source that it may be coming from.

This musical reminds us that it is not only important to think critically, but also to question everything. Do not fall victim to Fake News, lies or propaganda. Even if it is coming from a familiar face, or speaking though the false names of freedom, patriotism or religion. You are smarter than people think you are... don't let lies be shouted louder than the truth.
