Director's Note



Cannibal! The Musical is a rare find in American Musical Theatre. It is a show based on true events in our history, yet portrays this sad, gruesome story as a comedy, complete with songs and dances. I was first introduced to this show in college while working on a major project regarding serial killers with a focus on the ones who practiced cannibalism. With a minor in theatre, it was very rare that my major and minor overlapped, let alone I was boning in on

with the topics I was honing in on.

In my work and research, I covered many famous cases both for survival and as crimes. After days of sifting through full color crime scene photos from Jeffery Dahmer and only being able to read accounts of the Donner Party, I stumbled upon Alferd Packer. So much about his story and his case seemed unique and piqued my interest. But what truly struck me was that there still seemed to be no solid conclusions as to what actually happened. Now, this is not the first case I've seen like that, but this one in particular, seemed very over the top in how it was handled.

I truly believe that was why Trey Parker was drawn to it, as well. What I love so much about the musical is that this show takes place right where Trey Parker grew up. He wrote a show based upon the history of Colorado and the man that his college dining hall was named after. I believe that this show portrays a truly absurd and over the top telling of an absurd and over the top situation.

I grew up with the comedy of Trey Parker. I remember South Park first coming out when I was in kindergarten. And if there is one thing I've learned from Parker ,it's that no topic is off limits, that no one is safe from ridicule, and offending people with comedy is a powerful way to get a message across. I feel that, in 2019, the world has changed and in ways it has taken strides forward. But for many people, they believe this is a world where they have the right to not be offended. I disagree. You should hear different opinions, learn what people really think, because if we don't, then we will never grow. We will also never know who has crazy messed up opinions because they won't be sharing them. We don't all have to agree. We don't all have to take things seriously. At the end of the day, I firmly believe that if you're not saying something that offends someone, somewhere then you're not saying anything at all.

So strap in and get ready for an offensive, absurd show about murder and cannibalism . There are always unexpected surprises in Trey Parker's work and that's something I feel like he and I have in common. Also, look out for the cyclops.
