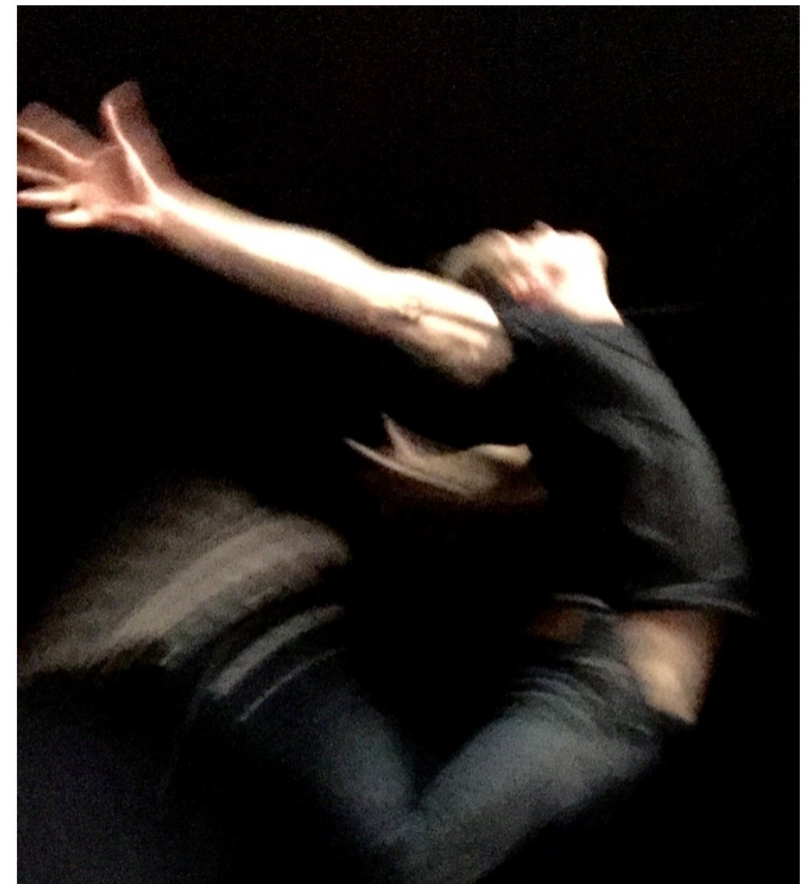

NOTES

Director's Note

Back when I was in the 8th grade, a few of my friends invited me to join at an audition for a show at the Palace Theatre in Manchester. Despite having very little singing, and almost zero dancing experience, I thought this sounded like a good idea. During the audition, I managed to fall flat on my face on the third step of the dance combination, which made such a loud bang when I hit the stage floor that the directorial team jumped and gasped. For some reason, they still decided to cast me in the show, and it was during this production that I absolutely fell in love with everything theatre. As someone who grew up playing sports and finding musicals a little silly, it was quite a shock to the system to enjoy rehearsing, dancing, and performing as much as I did. That show was Footloose The Musical. This show has held a very special place in my heart ever since, as it quite literally changed my life, and I am over the moon with exuberance that I get to return to this show and share it with the world once again.

Over the past several months as we prepared, rehearsed, and explored the ins and outs of Footloose, I have never stopped discovering new and deeper facets to the characters and story. This isn't just a story about dancing; it is about how we deal with all those aspects in our lives that are out of our control, how we mourn and heal after great loss, and how we attempt to cope with tragedy. It is unfortunate how relevant these themes are in our every day lives. As the actors dove into the complexities of their roles, I saw each of them uncover a heightened level of understanding and empathy. In the middle of the iconic pop and rock songs that have come to define the mid-1980s are some very real people deal with issues, which almost everyone has but no one can comprehend. How do we fill the holes in our lives after great loss? In his foreword to the script, playwright Dean Pitchford says "the major characters in Footloose have one trait in common: they are all survivors." Over the course of the performance, you will see characters of various ages and life experiences trying to handle their losses and protect what is important to them.

That is not to say this isn't a joyous show. We also see the important power of song and dance. The human soul has an undeniable need to express itself. I firmly believe this is why musicals aren't so silly after all, despite what the pre-14-year-old me would have told you. Sometimes regular words fail to properly express the intricate workings of our minds and souls and we need to use our whole bodies to help share them with the world. When people are denied a chance to express themselves in a healthy fashion, we sometimes lose important parts of our lives after bundling up these emotions and repressing our true feelings.

It has been a joy to see the growth in these young performers since we started rehearsing in May. In my short three years as a professional theatre artist, I can honestly say this is my proudest work as a director, and that comes out of the work we as a whole cast have achieved. The challenges handed out by this script would throw many seasoned actors for a loop, and these teens have stepped up to the plate to find the nuances inside their characters. Every character has suffered in some way, and even for those who have relatable life experience, suffering is not something easily dealt with on stage. As our process progressed, everyone became more comfortable with not hiding from the reality of the situation in each scene, and for that, I commend each one of them.

I would like to once more thank everyone involved in this process, both on-stage and behind the scenes. Making musicals of this scale happen is no small task, and it is heartwarming to see the love for the arts and the dedication to excellence in this community. I would also like to thank all of you for coming out to support these teens. I hope you are all ready to laugh, cry, and, most importantly, to cut footloose!

Stage Manager

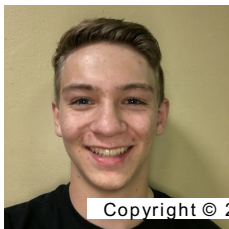

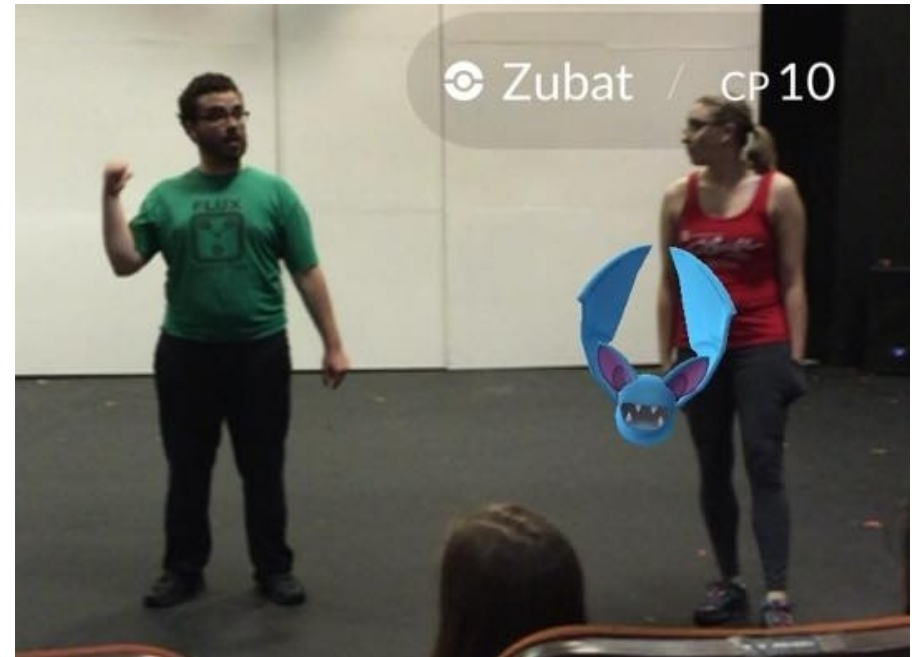


Andrew Seigny

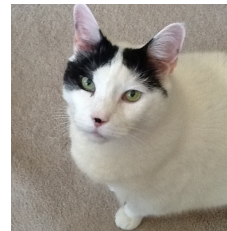

Gretchen Gray

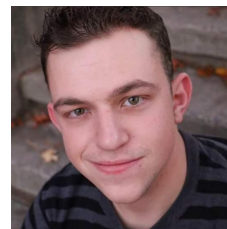
