





MUSIC MAN – SUMMARY

In July 1912, fast-talking traveling salesman 'Professor' Harold Hill comes to River City, Iowa, a town suspicious of strangers, especially ones trying to sell something. Harold calls himself a music professor, selling band instruments, uniforms, and the idea of starting a boy's band with the local youth. Harold meets up with his former partner in cons, Marcellus Washburn and they think the job is going to be a cinch. Harold decides he must 'create' a situation of concern for the citizens so that they will buy his idea of a boy's band, with himself as the leader. He convinces them that the new pool table in town is 'trouble,' and will only cause corruption of the city's youth. The way to fight this, of course, is with music and a band.

Harold encourages the ladies of River City to perform a show. When the School Board becomes suspicious of him, Harold forms them into a singing quartet. Families pay money to order instruments and uniforms, and, in return, Harold begins to teach the boys his revolutionary 'Think System' -- in order to learn the music, simply *think* about the melodies of the music in order to learn to *play* it.

Marian Paroo, the local librarian and part-time piano teacher, is not so easily convinced. She finds information to prove Harold is a fraud and fake. She is ready to tell Mayor Shinn; however, she has a change of heart, seeing her young brother Winthrop come out of his shell when he gets his new instrument for the band.

As the city is preparing to celebrate the Fourth of July, a rival salesman, Charlie Cowell, arrives to expose Harold and convince the townspeople to arrest him. They realize that even though he lied about the band, they are grateful for all his has done for their small town.
