Dear Audience,

Thank you for joining us for Anastasia. This show is special to me in more ways than I can count. Like many kids growing up in the '90s, I watched the animated movie more times than I could ever admit—and I still have a soft spot for Bartok! That film, with its sweeping music and strong characters, sparked something in me at a young age: a love of storytelling, of transformation, and of the magic that happens when someone discovers who they truly are.

Directing this stage production has been nothing short of magical. While the Broadway adaptation brings new depth and history to the story, it still carries that same spark—the wonder, the music, the hope.
